Post 16 Learning Agreement

This document comprises the Post 16 Agreement which outlines the expectations of students, parents/carers and the Academy, to maximise the potential of every student's learning.

The Academy agree to:

- Help develop the potential of every student.
- Provide clear guidance on the expectations of students.
- Support and monitor the academic progress of students through regular monitoring, mentoring and reporting.
- Monitor attendance and advise parents of concerns as soon as possible.
- Keep parents informed of progress via GO reporting system, parents' evenings, telephone calls etc.
- Respond to student and parent concerns.
- Provide a range of enrichment opportunities to enhance the academic and social attainment of students.
- Ensure that systems are in place to allow students to discuss any issues which affect them.
- To listen to the views and opinions of the student body.

Post 16 Students agree to:

- Work to their full potential in lessons, private study and in other activities.
- Complete homework and coursework to set deadlines.
- Attend registration and lessons (including tutorial, mentoring, study periods and enrichment programmes) regularly, in line with the Academy's attendance policy.
- Be punctual.
- Communicate effectively with staff if experiencing any difficulties or problems.
- Act as a responsible and committed member of the Academy community.
- Work in partnership with the Academy and the Post 16 team and accept any disciplinary decision made.
- Involve themselves as fully as possible with enrichment activities.
- Respect their environment to help create a pleasant and positive atmosphere within the Academy.
- Be a good role model to younger pupils by adhering to the ethos and expectations laid out by the Academy.

Parents/Carers agree to:

- Support their child in meeting the requirements of the attendance policy. Encourage them to attend regularly and to be punctual.
- Keep the Academy informed of any absence or issues that may affect their child's education and learning.
- Attend parents' evenings.
- Encourage their child to take responsibility for their learning and maintain a positive attitude to learning.
- Support the Academy positively by reinforcing the ethos and expectations of the Post 16 environment.
