# Destination Data 2016

## Year 11

- All students use impartial careers guidance to make choices about the next stage of their education, employment or training. A series of events throughout KS3 and KS4 provide students with careers education, engage students with local employers and training providers as well as universities – see Calendar of Events for specific details.
- The % of students progressing into further education, apprenticeships or employment with training is higher (98%) than the same measure in other Cambridgeshire mainstream schools (97%)
- All Year 11 students apply for Post 16 placements via UCAS Progress. Information is forwarded onto the Post 16 provider regarding FSM, LAC and SEN etc
- All Pupil Premium students and Identified students from a risk of NEET indicator have a careers interview with our guidance advisor
- Identified students will also have supported visits to local Post 16 Colleges to ensure all students receive conditional offers
- All student applications are tracked throughout Year 11 via UCAS progress
- Destination tracking data is available for 2016 to 2013 comparing pupil premium vs non-pupil premium.
- NEET numbers are low for Neale-Wade Academy and are lower than other Cambridgeshire schools in 2016.
- In general the % of pupil premium students into learning at the end of KS4 is similar to non-pupil premium

## Year 13

- HECFE identifies our catchment area as mainly in POLAR quintile area 2 and below with higher education participation rates at less than 25%. Work with NCOP supports projects and activities to address this both at Post 16 and key stages 3-4 – see Calendar of Activities
- The greater majority (over 70%) of learners progress to higher education after their study programme.
- Most students (over 80%) complete their study programmes with qualifications relevant to their career aims and move into education, apprenticeships or employment
- All Year 13 students and any Year 12 leavers receive high quality impartial careers advice that enables them to make well-informed decisions about their future plans.
- A range of activities are offered to students to support entry to both HE, apprenticeships and employment including personal statement and CV writing
- Students in Year 12 undertake work experience to support preparation to their chosen next steps
- Destination data is provided by the local authority but students are also tracked through UCAS and the Academy
- In 2016 62% of disadvantaged students (5) went onto higher education.
- The number of students progressing onto apprenticeships is increasing.

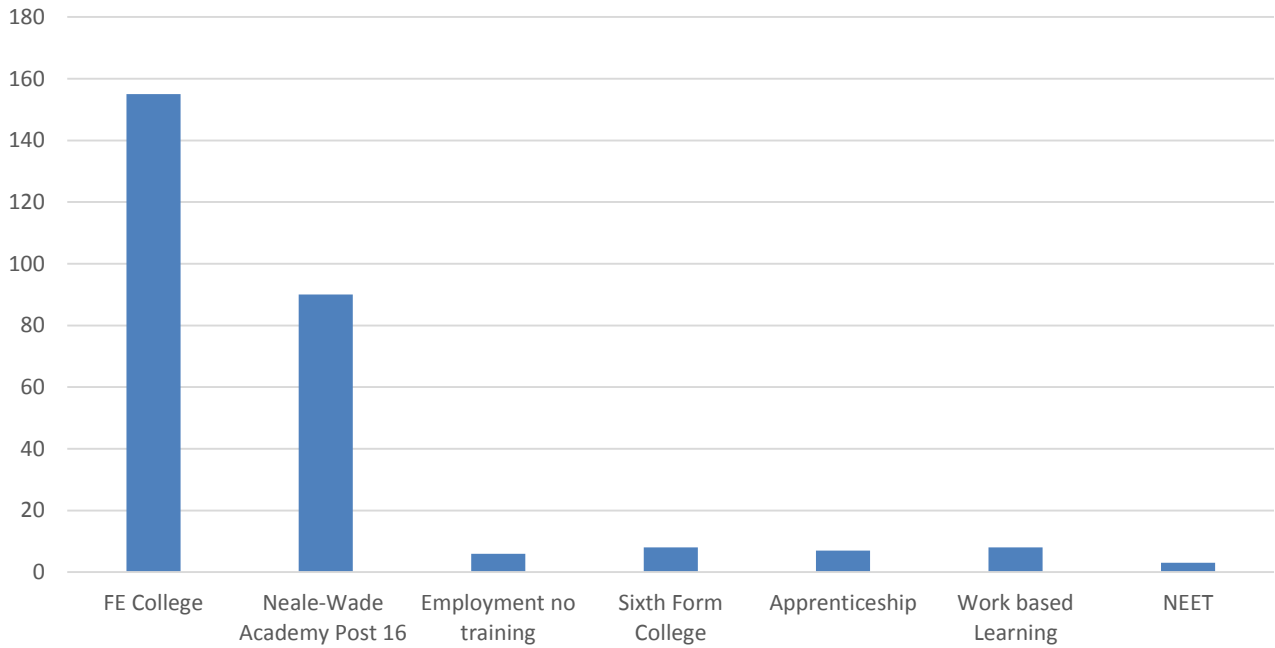

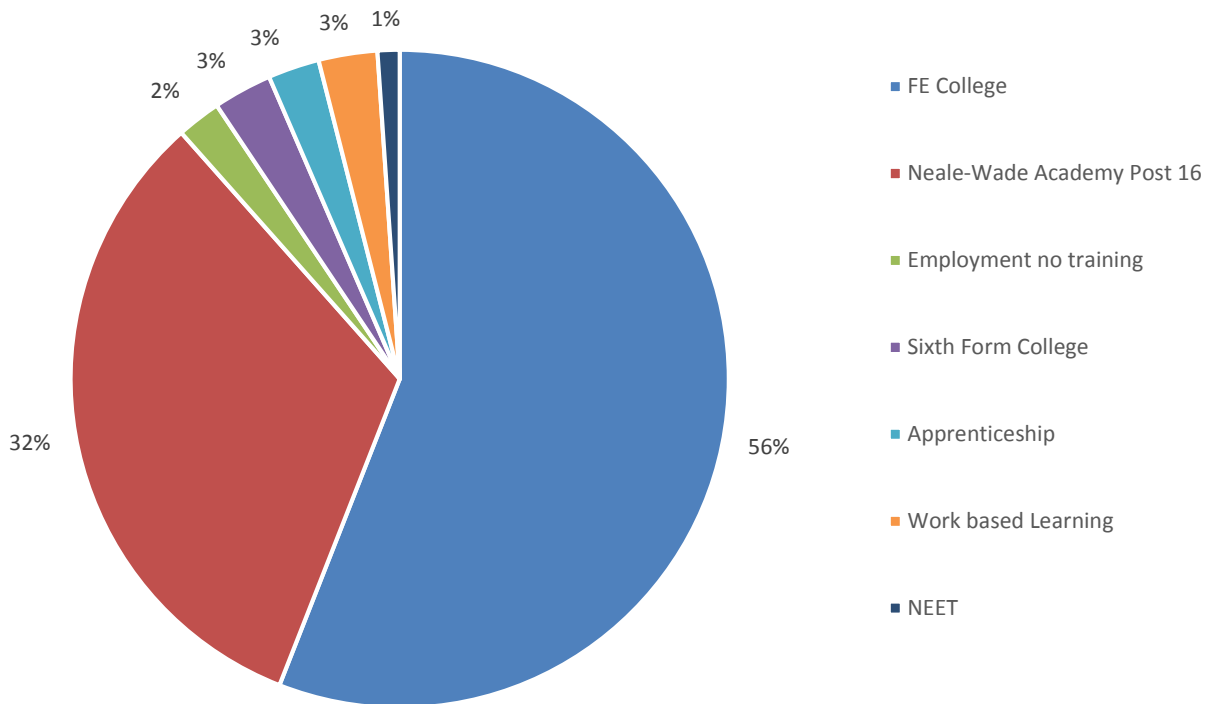

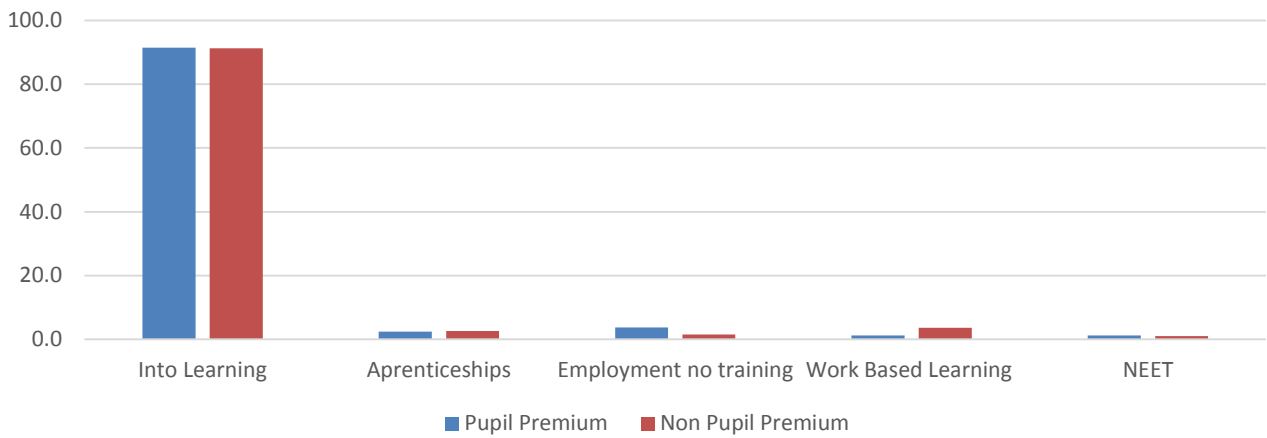


## % of Students at Each Destination Type

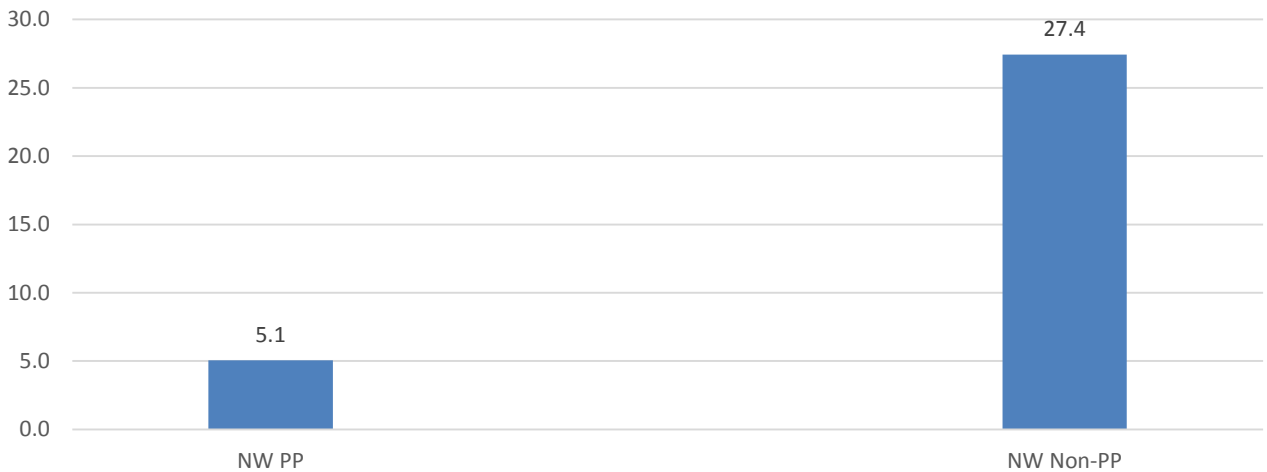

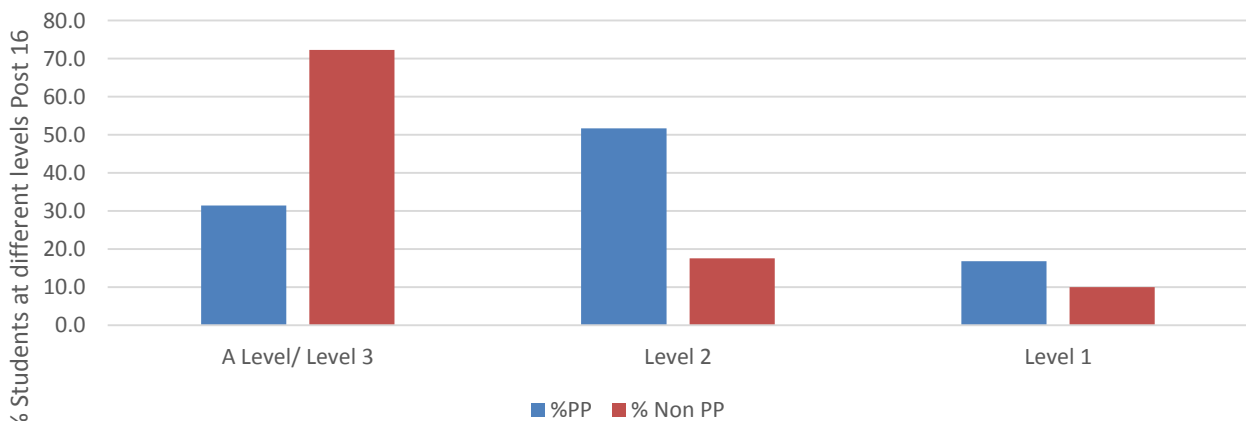
## Destination Data 2016 - % Year 11 Pupil Premium Compared to Non-Pupil Premium



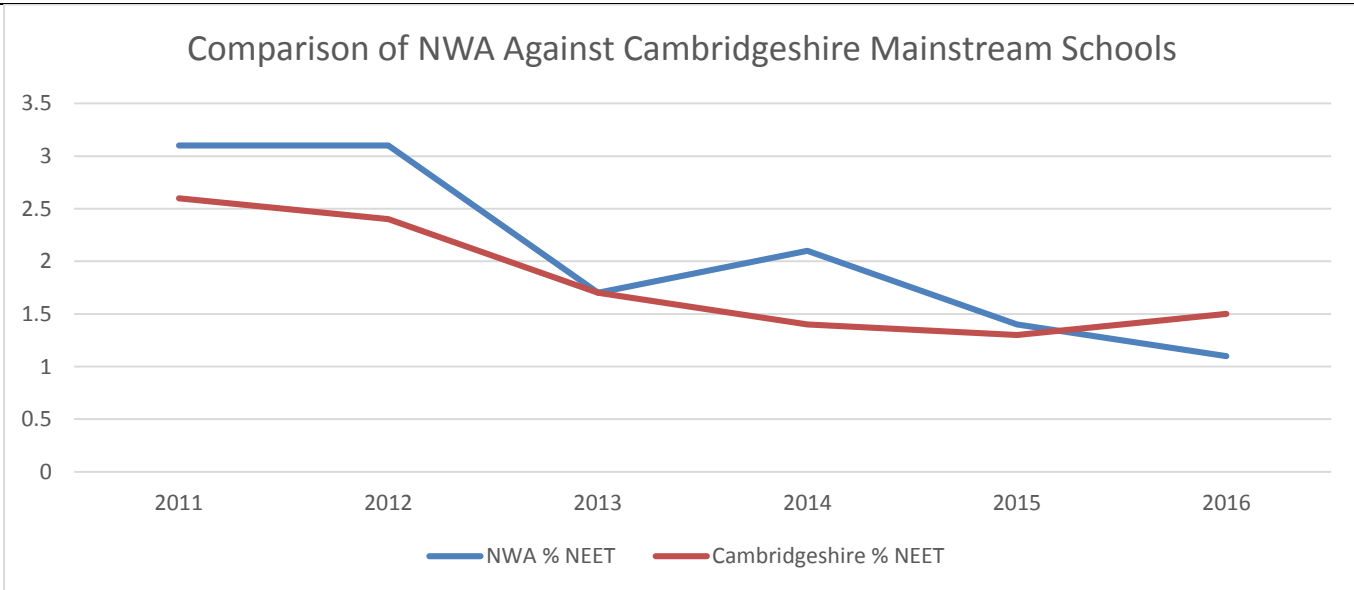
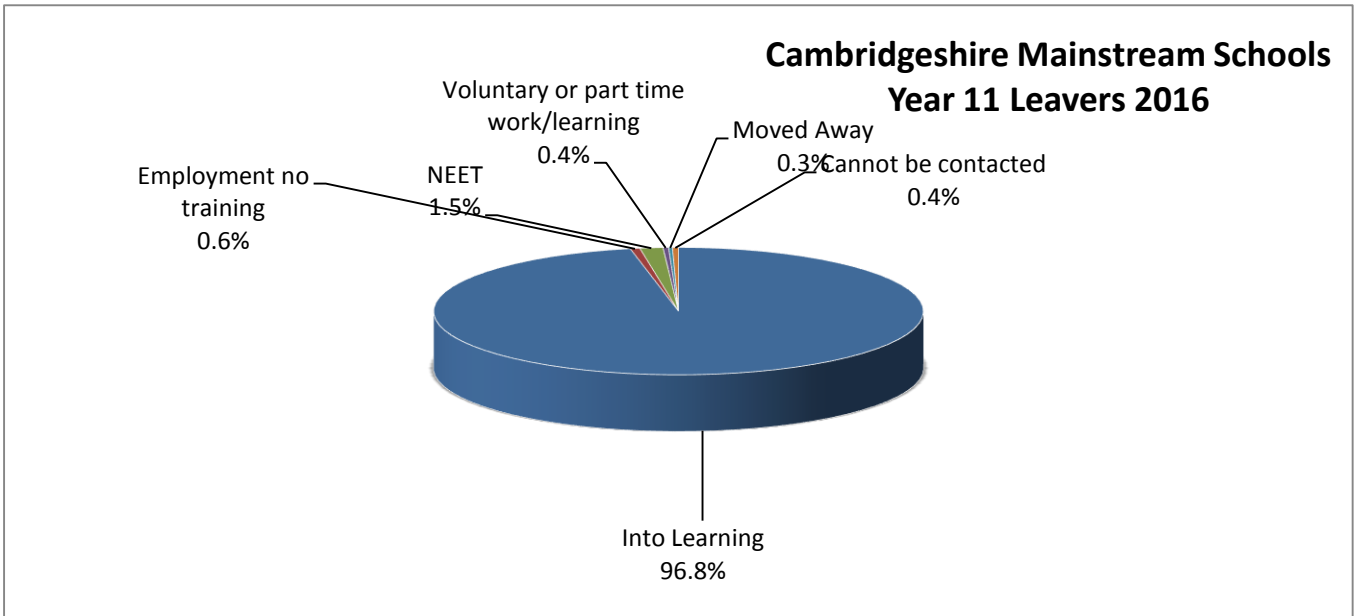
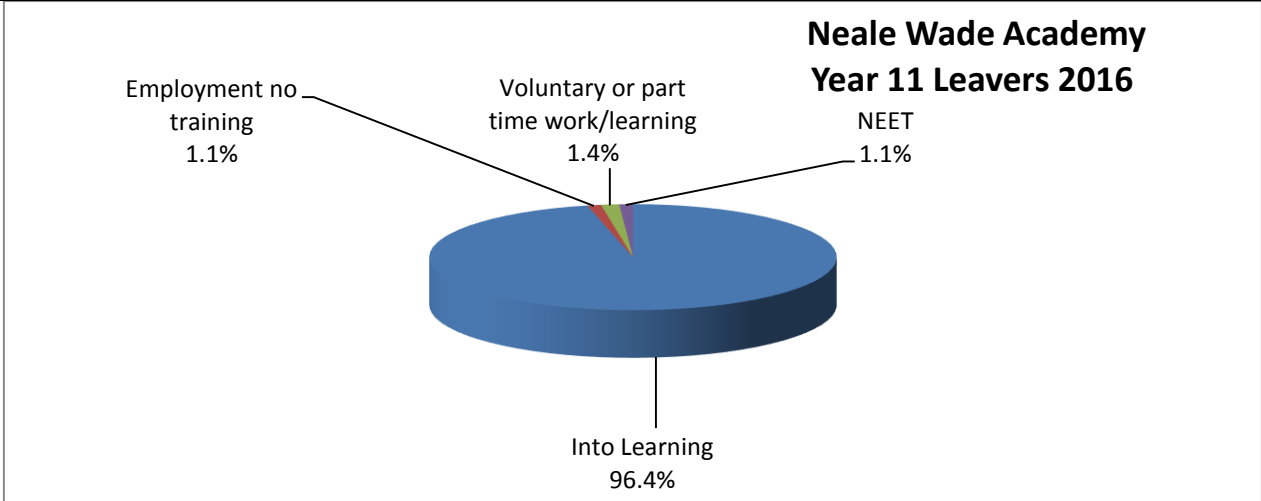
## % of Students Choosing Neale-Wade Academy for Post 16 Study Pupil premium compared with Non-Pupil Premium



## Comparison of Course level between Pupil premium and Non-Pupil Premium



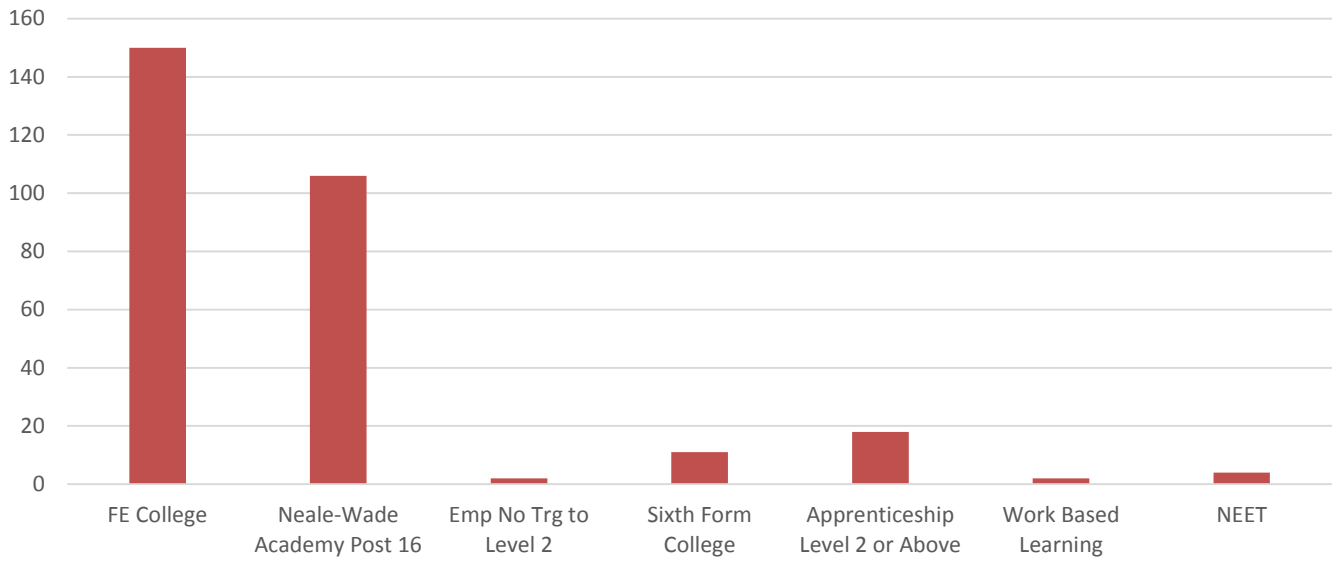

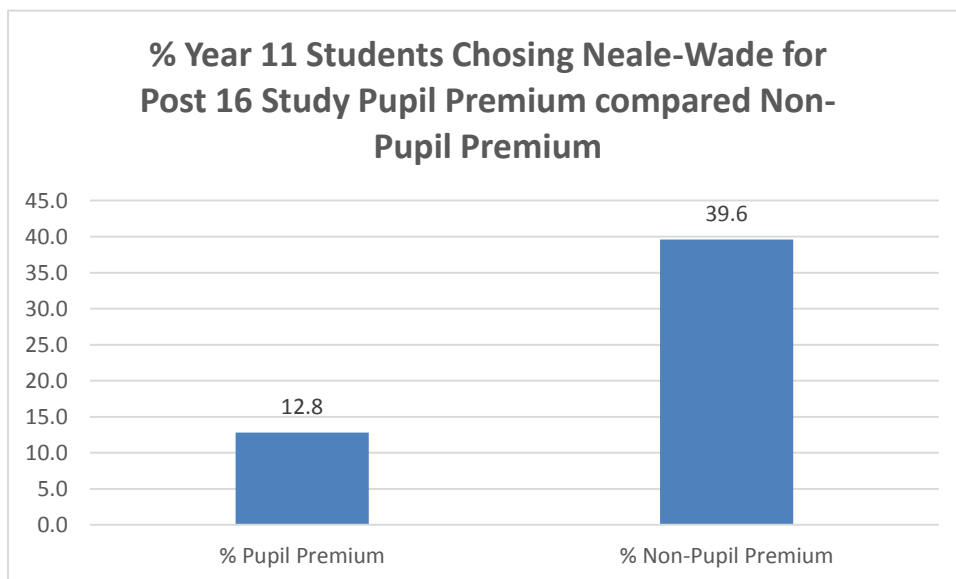
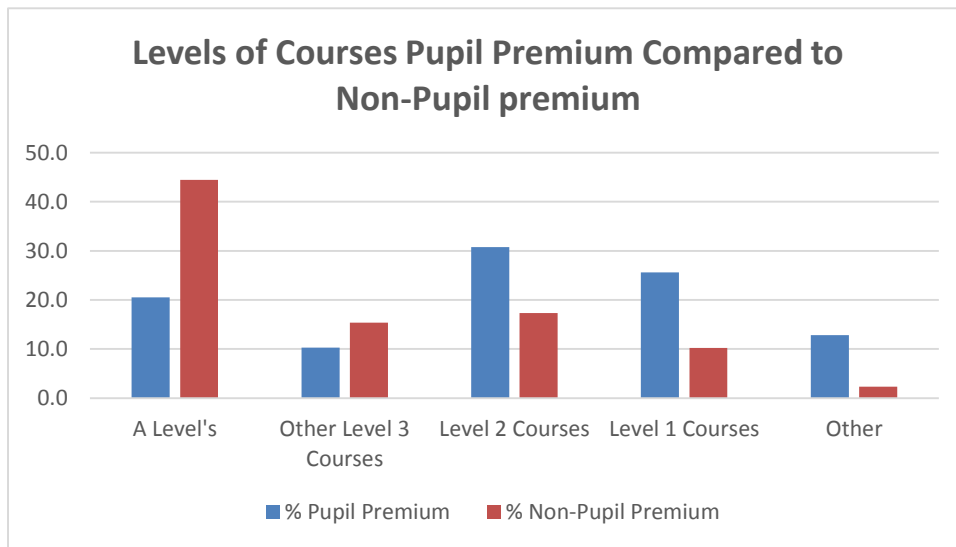
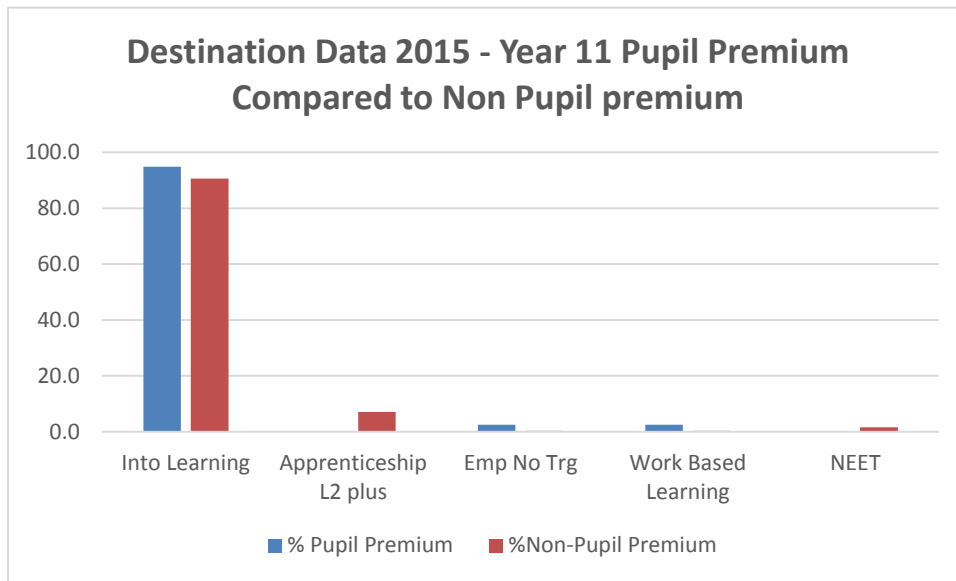


## % Students at Each Destination Type



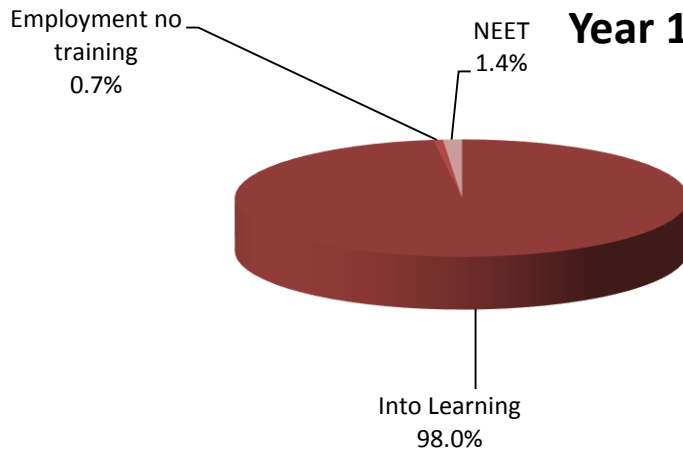

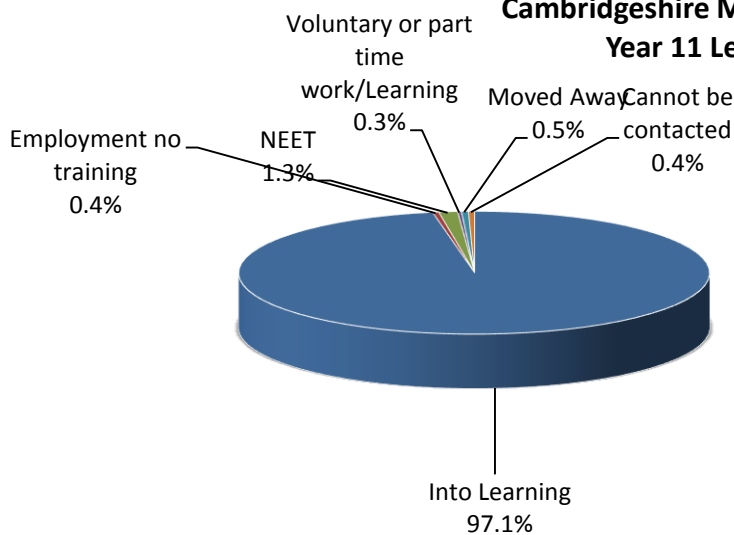

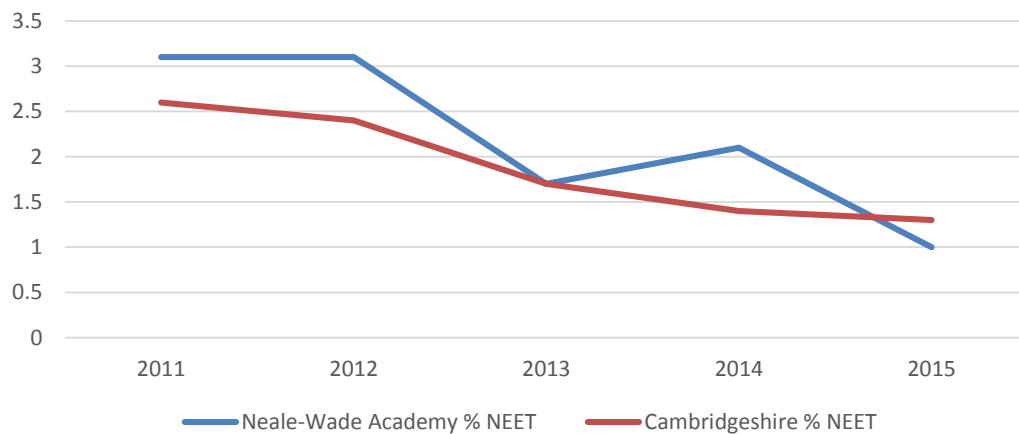
### Neale-Wade Academy Year 11 Leavers 2015



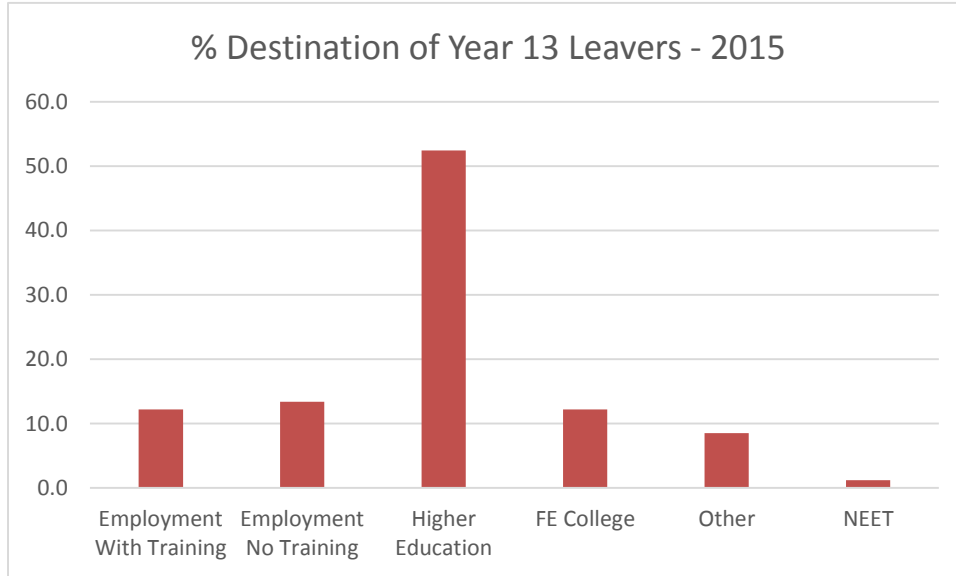
### Cambridgeshire Mainstream Schools Year 11 Leavers 2015

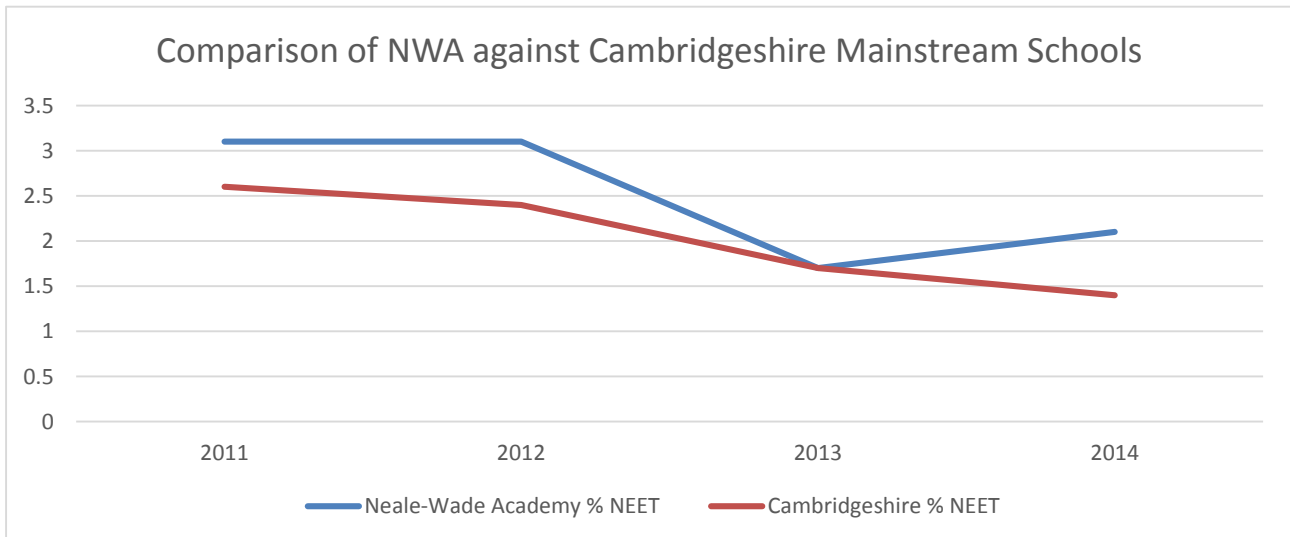
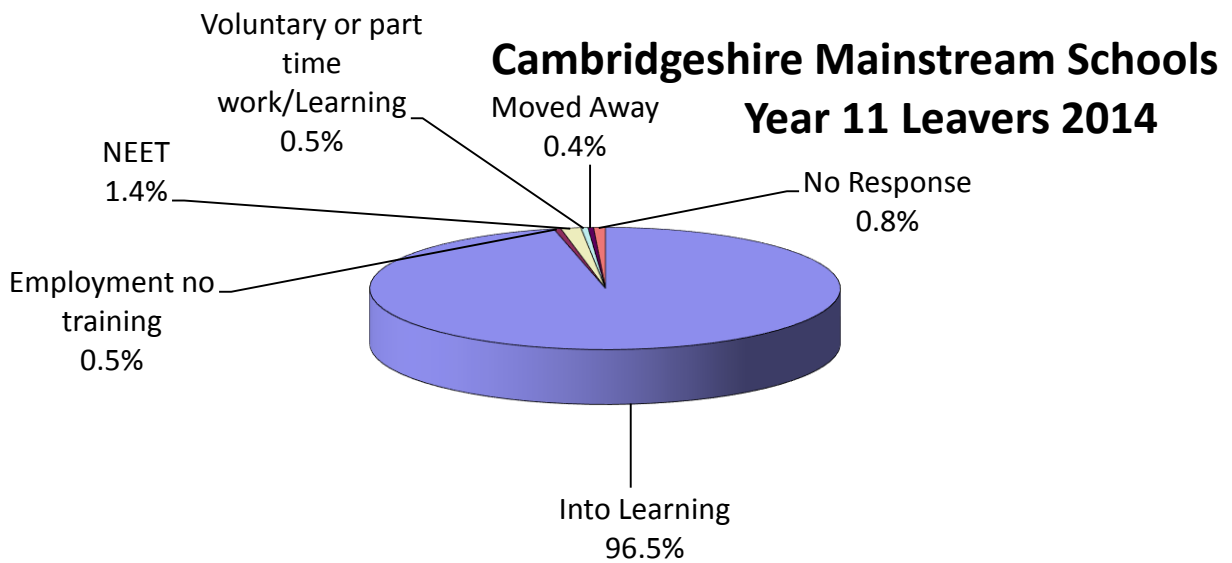
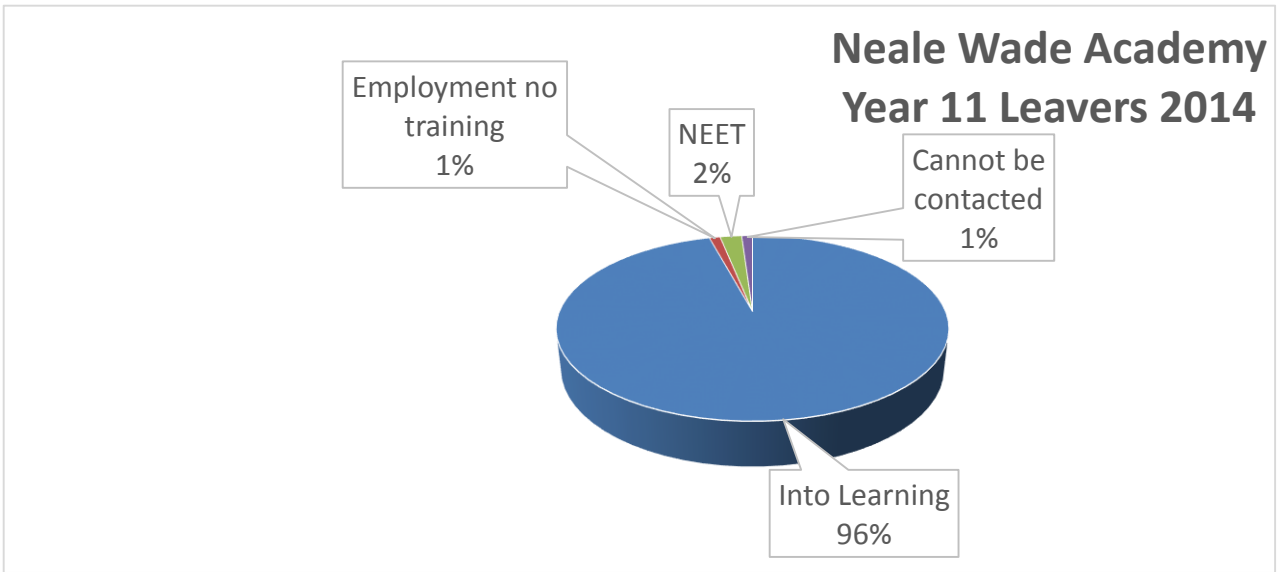
### Destinations of 2014 Year 11 Leavers



### % Students at each Destination Type

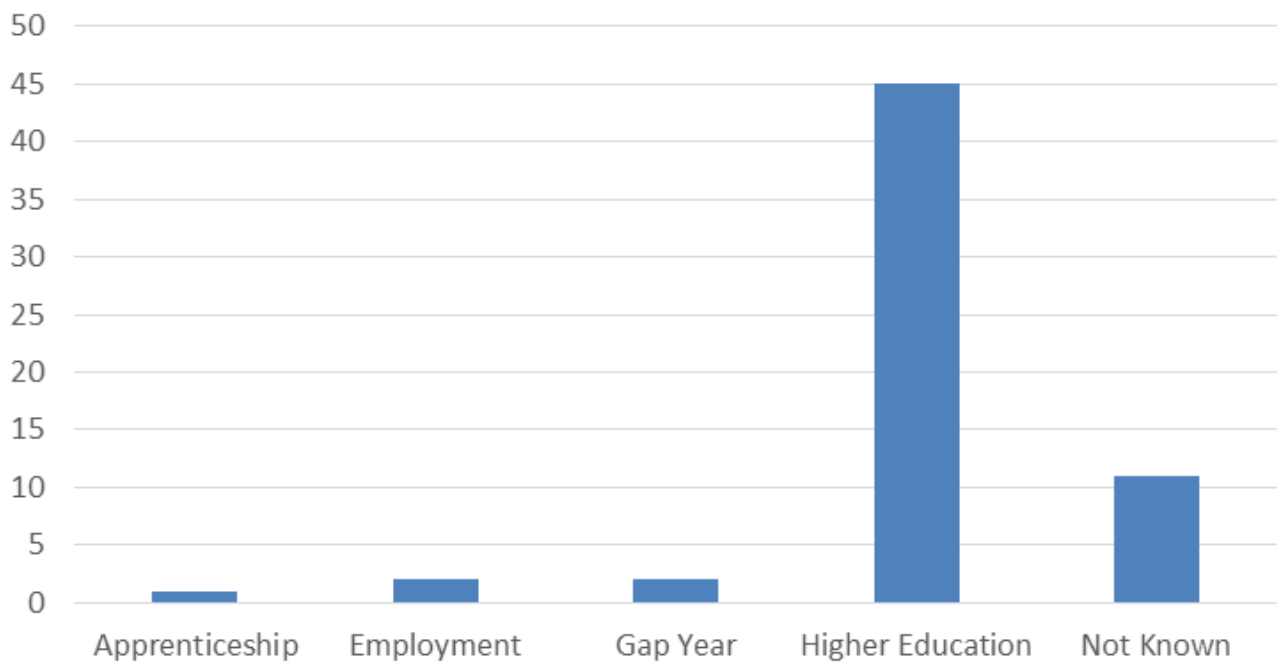

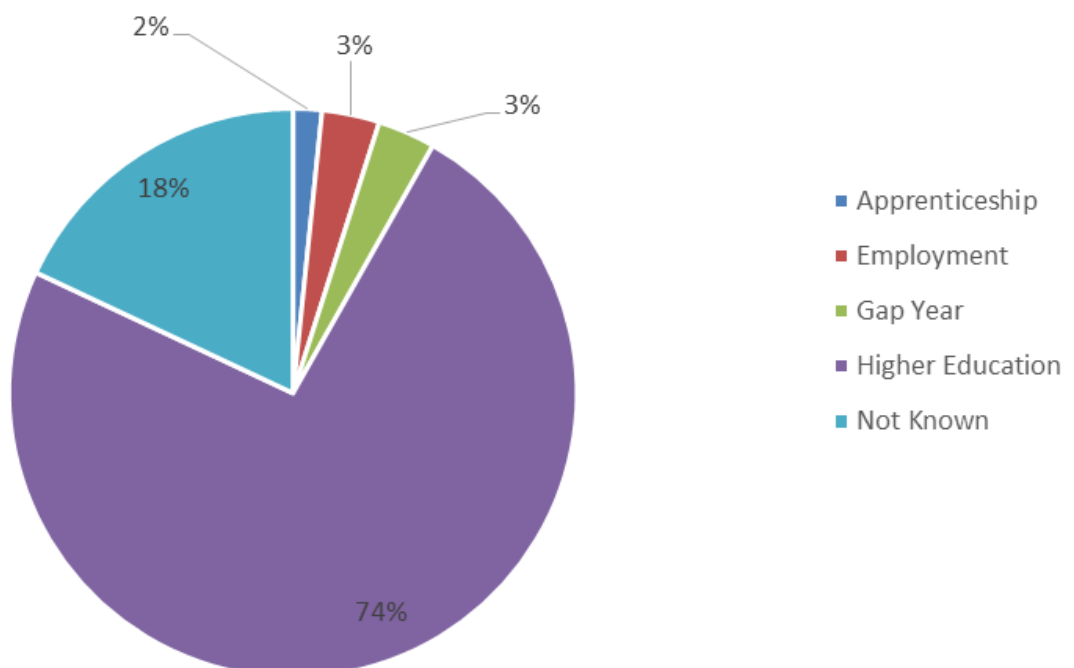

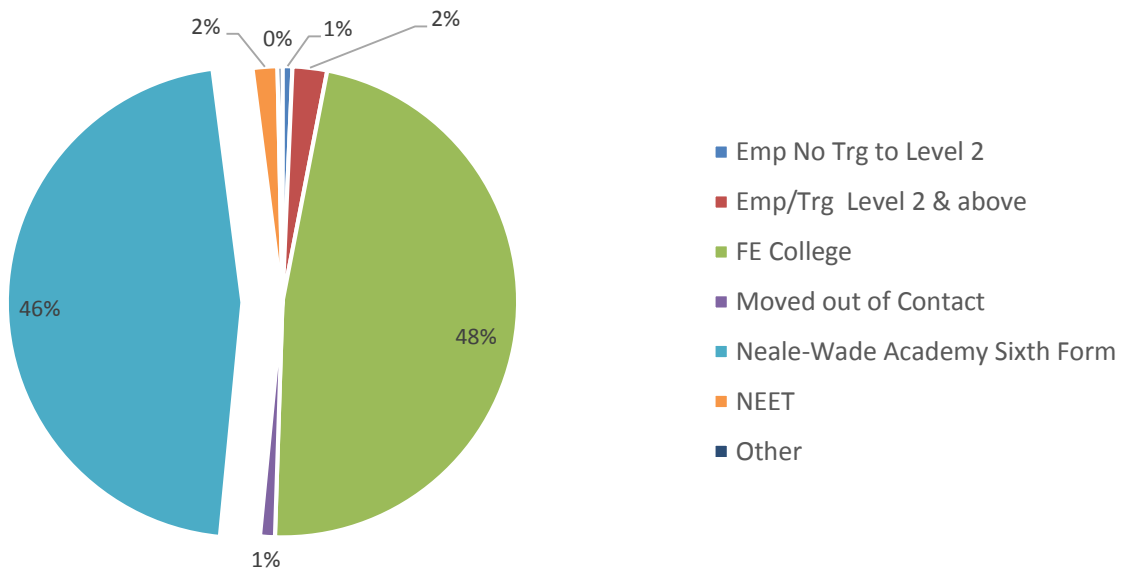

## Destination of 2013 Year 11 Leavers

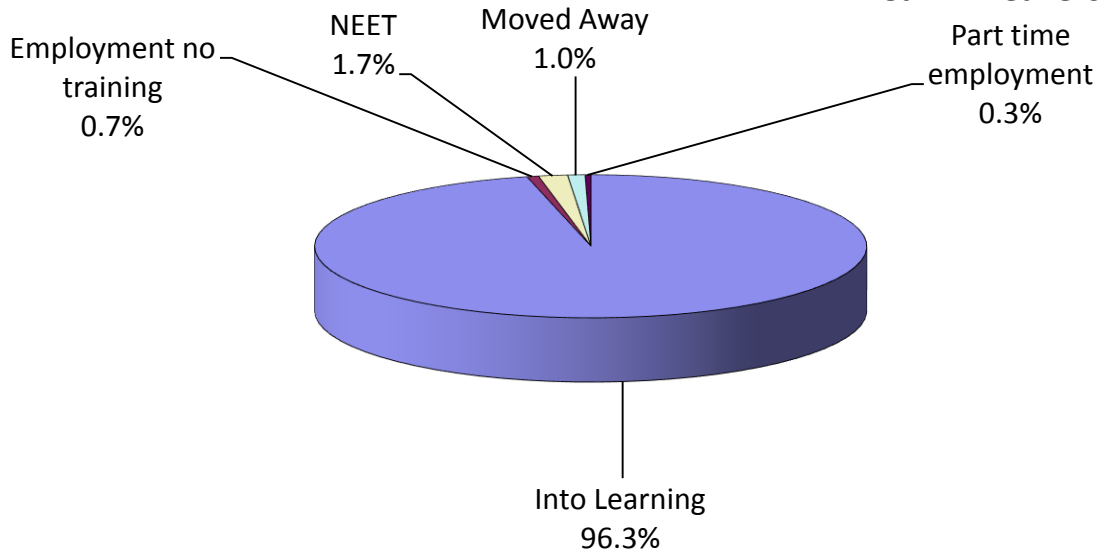


## % Leavers at Each Destination Type

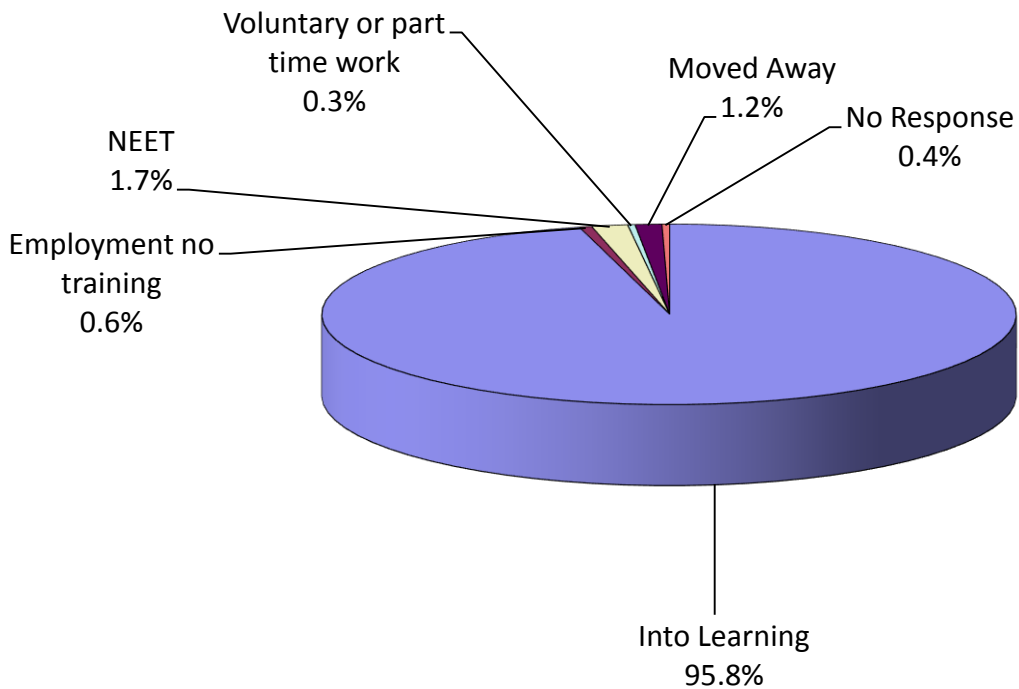

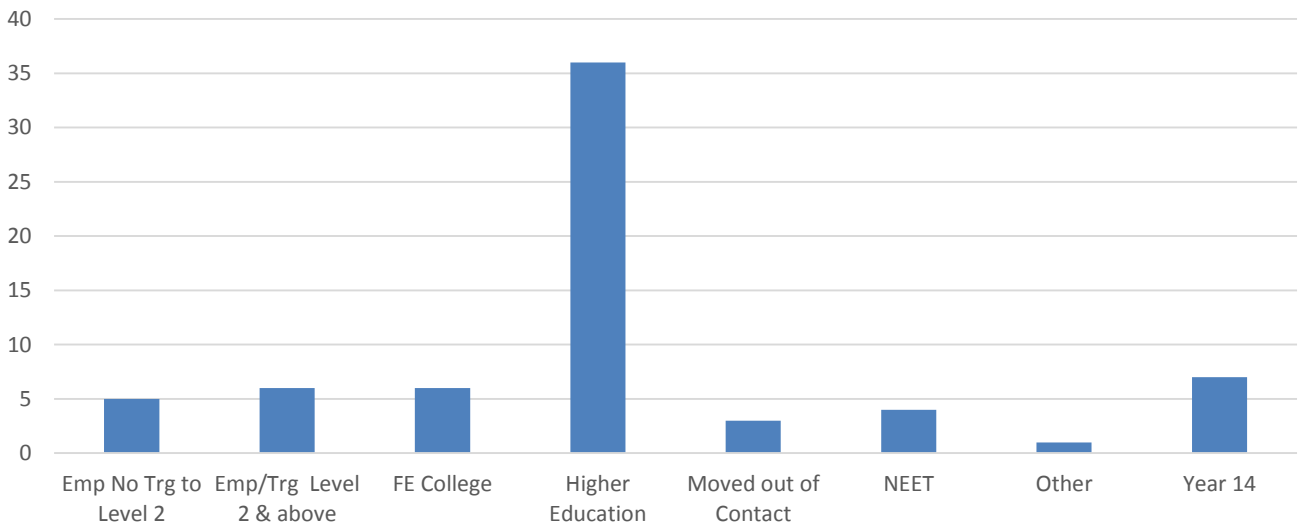


## Cambridgeshire Mainstream Schools Year 11 Leavers 2013
