Dear Parent/Carer

As you are aware the Academy operates a system of rewards and sanctions for both positive and negative behaviour choices.

Currently over 95% of all student choices are positive and this is a very pleasing statistic.

To further reduce the relatively small number of negative choices we will be operating a system of break-time and lunch-time detentions. Any student who receives a C2R during period 1 or period 2 will receive a break-time detention. Likewise, any student who receives a C2R during period 3 or period 4 will have a 20-minute lunch-time detention. All students with C2Rs issued during period 5 will attend the break-time detention on the next working day.

Students will be able to purchase food prior to break-time detention and following lunch-time detention.

These sanctions will only apply to a very small number of students and I am confident that over time, the number of detentions will diminish.

All students will be fully informed of the process during assemblies on their return after the half-term break and the system will commence from period 1 on Monday 25 February.
