Dear Parents/Carers

We are writing to you as part of our English transactional writing assessment. We are going to organise a fundraiser for the East Anglian Air Ambulance Service (EAAA). We will be writing several letters, creating posters, a press release and a newsletter as part of the assessment.

We have decided to support this charity because one of our friends recently suffered an asthma attack and they were called to help him. In addition to this, last year a Year 11 pupil from this school needed the EAAA to get her to the hospital in time to save her life, and they also saved Mrs Wilshire's life a few years ago.

We also know there is already a fund raiser happening for Cancer Research so we thought it would be good to choose a different charity to help.

The Air Ambulance fly 24/7 365 days a year and each mission costs almost £3000 and the East Anglian Air Ambulance Service is a charity which receives no government funding, so everything we raise will help them a lot.
