Re: School uniform

I am writing to remind you of our Academy uniform expectations.

Uniform requirements remain the same but it is important to remind you that all skirts must be of knee length. Please do not purchase a skirt that is shorter than knee length as this is not suitable.

Any students who are not in full school uniform from September will not be in mainstream lessons until the uniform issue is addressed

Please contact the Academy on 01354 606000 if you require further information. Full school uniform requirements are listed below.

BOYS

- Black blazer with Academy logo
- Plain black trousers – standard tailored style - *strictly no jeans*
- White shirt
- Clip on tie
- Burgundy v-neck jumper
- Ankle socks – black or white

- Shoes – black leather or synthetic, no logos or markings
- Winter coat – sensible outdoor coat which can be worn over full uniform, specifically no hooded sweatshirts

GIRLS

- Black blazer with Academy logo
- Plain black skirt – knee length or
- Plain black trousers– standard tailored style - *strictly no jeans or leggings*
- White reverse collar blouse
- Burgundy v-neck jumper
- Ankle socks – black or white
- Tights – plain black or flesh colour
- Shoes – black leather or synthetic, no logos or markings
- Winter coat – sensible outdoor coat which can be worn over full uniform, specifically no hooded sweatshirts

Mouthguards

The PE faculty are introducing hockey to the curriculum for Years 7-9 to extend the number of sporting and competitive opportunities for our students. It is strongly advised that

students wear mouthguards for both hockey and rugby. The wearing of shin pads is also advised for both football and hockey lessons.

Students will still be expected to participate irrespective of them having this equipment, however they may not be able to fully access all aspects of the lesson.

Mouthguards are relatively inexpensive and can be purchased from a variety of outlets or from your dentist.

Cycle helmets

There is an increasing number of students who cycle to and from the Academy and this is good to see as it helps to foster a healthy lifestyle.

It is strongly recommended that all students who cycle do wear an approved cycle helmet.
